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Research on the Strategy of Integrating Excellent Traditional Chinese Culture into the Ideological and Political Education Curriculum of English Majors

3.3. Reform teaching concepts and dig deep into traditional culture

The value of life does not lie in acquiring money, fame, and power, but in making due contributions to society and the country and becoming part of the history of the country's development. In this way, teachers can not only expand the teaching content and teach students English knowledge more effectively, but also carry out patriotic education to students, so that students can become the "new youth of the time" in line with the needs of society and the development of the country [14].

3.4. Reform college English classroom teaching methods

Taking the Dragon Boat Festival as an example, the Dragon Boat Festival is mainly to commemorate the Chu Qu Yuan. Teachers can make an in-depth analysis of Qu Yuan and share with students the great patriotic spirit and noble feelings behind him. This will not only help students to better learn and understand the traditional cultural knowledge but also promote students to shape excellent character and promote their all-round growth [15].

In addition, teachers can also apply project-based teaching methods, flipped classrooms, and other teaching methods to their teaching, to stimulate students' interest, mobilize their enthusiasm and initiative, and help students establish correct ideas and values while teaching students English knowledge, to promote their all-round development.

In short, to carry out and implement the fundamental task of building morals and cultivating people, it is of great practical significance to integrate excellent traditional culture into English curriculum thinking and politics.
